

Competition Secretary Annual Report

Dear Members,

What a fantastic season we have just completed.

This season we had 61 registered teams. You know a club is doing well when they have a huge number of Small Sided Games teams.

At 36 we are ranked equal 3rd for SSG teams and our mini fields are fit to burst every weekend. 7 Under 6's, 9 Under 7's, 7 Under 8's, 5 Under 9's, 5 Under 10's and 3 Under 11's.

Add to that our very successful Junior (U12-U17) teams. Of the 17 Junior Teams registered, 11 of them qualified for the semi-finals,

10 of which qualified for the finals, 7 of which qualified for the Grand Final and 4 of them were crowned Champions.

5 of our Junior teams were crowned Premiers.

Our senior teams were also successful, all 8 senior teams qualified for the Semi-Finals, with 5 making the Finals and with 2, not only making the Grand-Finals, but winning them as well.

Our AA5 and AA9 were both crowned Premiers.

Our two MFA Cup teams had great runs.

Our Ladies MFA Cup Team were made up from our Ladies 1, Under 18's and Under 16's girls.

To make the Final they beat Eschol Park, Uniting Church and Minto before winning the Cup against Mt Annan 5 - 0.

Not to be outdone, the Men's team, made up from our AA5, AA6, AA9, U17 and O35/2's, made the final by beating

very strong Mt Annan, Ingleburn and Camden Falcons teams before winning their Cup against Eschol Park 6 - 2.

This was the first time any club had won both competitions in the same year. A fantastic effort by the Hornets.

Finally, on a personal note, I will be standing down as Competition Secretary for the 2016

season. Thank you to all for your support of our 2015 committee

and I'm sure those who will come into the 2016 committee will continue the great work these people do.

The only thing left to say is ... Bring on March 2016 (its only 20 weeks away) !
